## Coastal Carolina Aquatic Association League Policy on Alcohol and Tobacco Passed April 22, 2009

**Alcohol and tobacco** products are **prohibited** at **all** CCAA events.

CCAA swimming is an organized children's sporting competition. As such, in keeping with the policies of USA swimming, and all other organized children's sporting leagues, the use of **alcohol and tobacco** are prohibited at CCAA swim meets.

The CCAA recognizes that many of our member pools are located at country clubs that service patrons other than those attending the swim meet.

The league **expects** those teams to restrict access to the pool deck area for people who are being served alcohol or using tobacco products.

Direct contact with the swimmers and the pool deck area is to be restricted.
